Sydney Monorail has been an iconic landmark and Darling Harbour attraction for 25 years. One of only a few city monorails in the world, it glides over busy streets, offering unrivalled views of Sydney and connects the city's top shopping and hotels with Darling Harbour's dynamic attractions. With the Monorail closure now confirmed for 30 June 2013, catch a piece of history before it's gone.

Operates daily every 5 minutes (Closed Christmas Day)  
7am – 10pm Mon to Fri, 8am – 10pm Sat and Sun

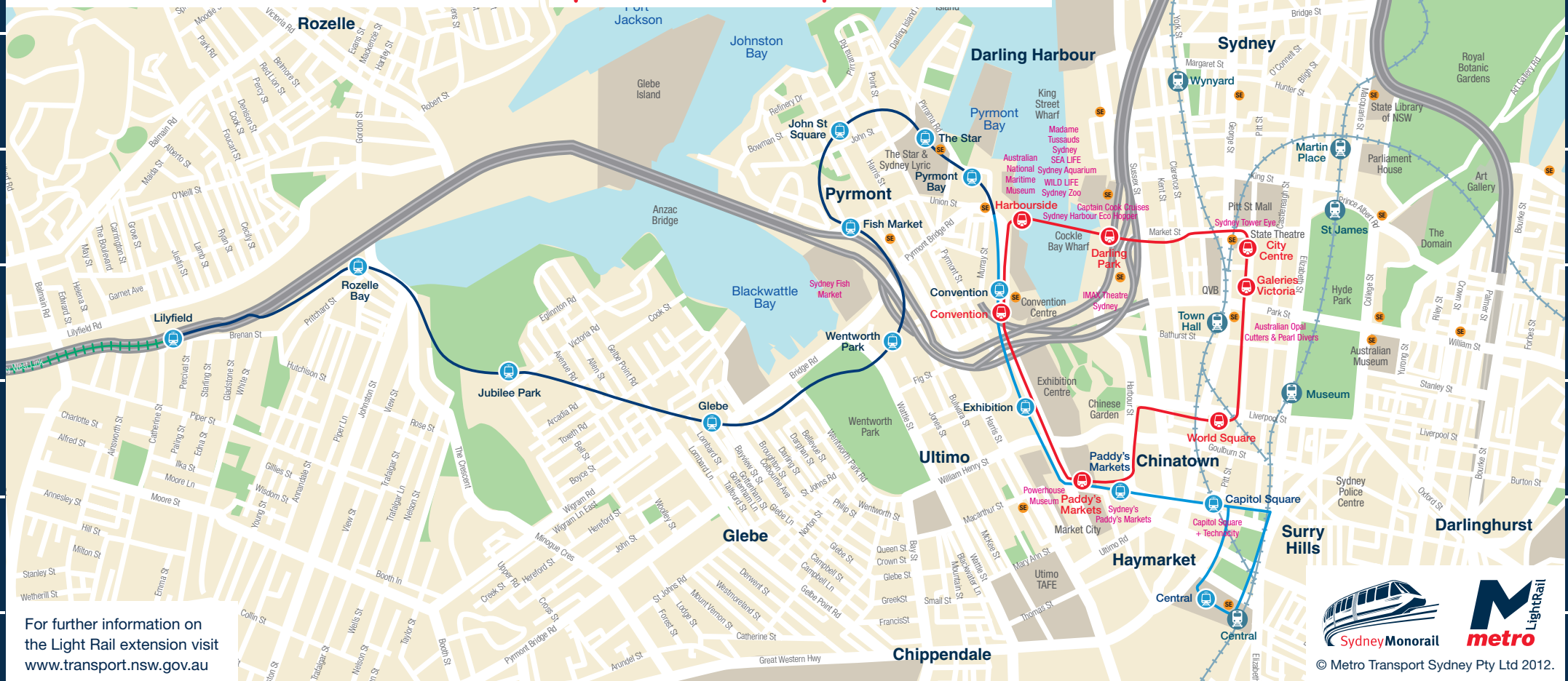
