### How to Book

Advance bookings are required for groups of 10 or more people and are subject to availability.

Group bookings are not confirmed until a confirmation email has been issued. Final group numbers are required 48 hours prior to arrival.

### Conditions of Visit

Monorail - Individual Monorail carriages carry a maximum of 16 people. Larger groups will be split and spread across other carriages/vehicles.

No food or drink is permitted inside the vehicles.

### **Group FOC Policy**

One free entry for tour operator, driver or guide with every 10 paying customers (must show identification at point of entry).

Applies to staff escorting groups only and not to pre-purchased tickets.

### **Exclusive Charter Cancellation Policy**

The following cancellation policy applies

20% payable if group cancelled 14 days to 7 days 50% payable if cancelled 7 days to 24 hours 100% payable if cancelled within 24 hours

MTS reserves the right to cancel bookings immediately by written notice to the operator at any time without cause. If MTS cancels a booking, MTS will refund any refund any prior payment.

### Payment Methods

### FIT/Group bookings

There are two options for payment. Full payment can be made by credit card or direct deposit at time of booking or licensed operators can apply for a credit account. To be eligible for a credit account you will need to complete a Credit Application Form for assessment and approval. Subject to approval, operators will then be authorised to use company vouchers to conduct visits on Sydney Monorail.

### Pre-purchased bulk tickets

Approved operators will be invoiced at time of booking. Payment terms are 30 days from date of invoice.

Metro Change - Ticket Exchange Vouchers

Approved operators will be invoiced upon voucher redemption. Payment terms are 30 days from date of invoice.
