Also included in every Monorail Family Day Pass is a free souvenir *Eye Spy Up High* activity fun sheet where families can test their knowledge of the city as they enjoy farewell Monorail trip. This activity sheet highlights 25 sights for families to spot while they fly above the city for one last time.
