World Square

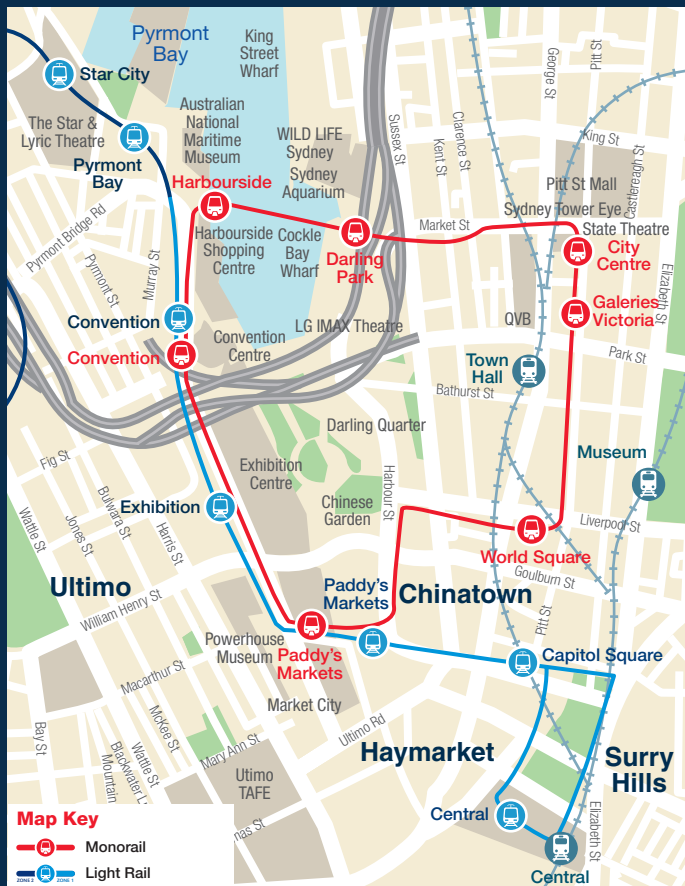
Access via Liverpool Street World Square Shopping Centre, Sydney

Monorail Smart is smart ticket technology that saves you time, is easy, safe and reliable plus also offers significant discounts for regular Monorail passengers.



Where do I get Smart?

Purchase Monorail Smart at any Monorail station and register your card at the same time by providing your contact details. Your Smart card is then set to rechargeable and you're ready to 'touch & go'.

How Smart works?

Simply touch the turnstile reader – no need to remove it from your wallet – a trip is deducted, you're on your way. The turnstile reader will display your current ride balance, so you can monitor your usage levels and know when to recharge.

How do I recharge?

Monorail staff will recharge your Smart card at the station any time for \$3.30 per trip.

Why do you need my contact details?

By providing your contact details, you register your Smart card and also protect your money. In the case of your card being lost or stolen, let us know and your card will be cancelled and replaced with exactly the same value on it for a small admin fee (\$10)*.

Are there other Smart benefits?

By registering your card, you will receive emails of special offers in and around the network.

How does the Monorail closure affect Smart?

While the NSW Government has confirmed Sydney Monorail will close 30 June 2013, all Smart cards and their associated ride balances will remain valid up to and including this date.*

How much does Smart cost?

Monorail Smart **\$25 including 6 trips**
Electronic 'touch & go' card – rechargeable

Monorail Smart recharge **\$3.30 per trip**
Standard Monorail fare \$5.00 per trip
